

LAGOON HILL SAUVIGNON BLANG 2018

Type of wine: White Varietal: Sauvignon Blanc Region: Awatere Valley and

Winemaking: Mechanically harvested from selected sites in Marlborough's Lower Awatere and Upper Wairau Valleys at optimum ripeness. The grapes were destemmed and gently pressed, then fermented cool in stainless steel tanks with various yeast strains to deliver classic clean and vibrant flavors typical of Marlborough.

Winemaker: Andrew Parley Farming practices: Sustainable

Soils: Alluvial and loess soils over gravels

On the nose, the wine displays lifted aromas of tropical fruits (Asian pear, passion fruit, finger limes) and green apple. Vibrant and full on the palate with flavors of juicy ripe nectarines, white peaches, satsuma and yuzu, along with a touch of tarragon. The finish is long and lingering. An elegant style made for enjoying with good food and good friends.
