IGP PAYS D'HERAULT, FRANCE

Type of wine: Rosé

Viticulture: 40 year old vines, planted at around 5000 vines per ha on selected plots

across the Languedoc. In this

sunny corner of France grapes can ripen to full maturity and express great varietal character. The sandy limestone and clay soils ensure naturally low yields, the perfect conditions for producing rich, concentrated, ripe grapes.

Winemaking: The grapes are harvested at night when the temperature is cool, in order to protect them from oxidation. The juice is collected after a gentle pressing and is cooled down very quickly. Fermentation is at low temperatures to keep the fruit character. The wine stays on its fine lees at least two months.

Winemaker: Multiple

Farming practices: Sustainable

Soils: Sandy limestone and clay



Bright pink, this is a light and refreshing Rosé bursting with red fruits, lychee and green apple, a perfect balance of roundness and length which makes for an easy drinking wine for all seasons.
